



Project Access Nashville Specialty Care Income Requirements

In order to qualify for Project Access Nashville Specialty Care, a patient's household income must fall 200% or below the federal poverty line. Requirements vary based on each patient's household situation, so please call our office at 615-712-6237 to speak with one of our bilingual care navigators to find out what works best for you.

Examples of Acceptable Financial Documentation:

1. If you and/or a spouse are currently working, submit:
 - a) Four weeks' worth of paystubs from the last 90 days OR
 - b) A copy of your most recent tax return OR
 - c) A detailed letter of employment provided by your employer. For a template, please call the PANSC office at 615-712-6237.
2. If you and/or a spouse receive government benefits, submit a copy of the most recent letter that states the amount of your benefits. The following are accepted: food stamp letter, unemployment benefit letter, social security or disability statement, or housing assistance statement.
3. If you do not work or receive benefits, you may submit a PANSC Advocacy Form. This form is available on our website or by calling 615-712-6237.
4. If you are residing in a homeless shelter, you may provide a verification letter from the shelter.

It is critical that you provide all income information for you, and your spouse if applicable, in order for PANSC to accurately evaluate your potential eligibility for these services.
